To effectively realise value from the natural resources of the UK seabed, including facilitation of 8-10 GW of operational offshore wind capacity (by 31 March 2020)	5.3 GW of installed grid operational capacity achieved.	<b>On track</b>
Achieve BREEAM ‘excellent’ rating on all completed, commercial office projects overseen by the Development team (ongoing).	Completed BREEAM ratings over 2016/17: 1 New Burlington Place – Excellent St James Market- Excellent	<b>Achieved</b>
Zero operational waste to landfill where we have control (ongoing)	100% of waste diverted from landfill across the portfolio.	<b>Achieved</b>
