¹ This is 20 working days or, rarely, in the case of 'complex and voluminous' requests under EIR, and requests under FOIA where additional time is required to consider the public interest test, 40 working days.

² It is important to note that where we provide information but redact a small amount of information (e.g. a member of staff's name), this will count as a partial refusal. In addition, where information is already published on our website or where an individual has posed a question which is too broad to answer, this will also count as a refusal.
