Response
<p>Thank you for your request for information. You asked for the “owner or trustee (or other suitable term) of the property”:</p> <p>20 Hanna Court St. George's Place Cheltenham Gloucestershire England GL50 3LA</p> <p>I can confirm that this property is not owned by The Crown Estate and we do not keep records of properties we do not own. However, the Land Registry holds information regarding land and property ownership.</p> <p>You can find out if a property is registered, find the owner and how far its general boundaries extend by ordering an official copy of the register. There is a fee – for example a copy of the title register for a property is currently £3.</p> <p>https://www.gov.uk/search-property-information-land-registry</p> <p>Alternatively, if you are a council tenant it is likely that the property is owned by your local authority, and you could contact them to confirm whether this is the case.</p>
