Thank you for your email of 12 June 2019, in which you asked for information on Crown Estate revenue through renewables in each of the last 10 years, in a) England, b) Wales, c) Scotland, and d) Northern Ireland.

Please find this information in the table below. Please note that the figures reflect totals in millions of pounds. Renewables revenue includes off-shore wind (which makes up most of the renewables income), wave and tidal, interconnectors, and some gas storage. Please note that interconnectors are included because they have in recent years been classified as renewables in the regional reports.
