Subject: Frogmore Cottage Renovations and Ownership Near Lichfield

Request response

I am writing in response to your information request of 30 June 2019, in which you asked two questions. We have considered those questions in line with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

First of all, you ask about the renovations that were carried out on Frogmore Cottage. We do not hold any information about this as it is outside the remit of The Crown Estate.

By way of background, The Crown Estate has been established by an Act of Parliament as an independent commercial business. We return all of our profit to the Treasury. This has totalled £2.8bn over the last ten years.

In relation to your second question about Lichfield, I can confirm that all of The Crown Estate's ownership is available to view on its website here. There is some rural estate near to Lichfield which forms part of The Crown Estate portfolio and I have attached a map of this for your convenience.

I hope that this information is helpful. However, if you are not satisfied with this response, you may complain or appeal our decision, which will be investigated through an Internal Review.
