Request response
<p>I am writing further to your email of 14 August 2019, which we have considered in line with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).</p> <p>You have asked about Swinley Forest and whether the bike skills area has been built and funded by The Crown Estate or by a third party. As you may be aware, the Crown Estate owns the area to which you refer but this is leased out to Swinley Bike Hub for an annual fee. The area has received a capital investment of £20,000 from The Crown Estate this business year, and additional investment has also been made by the Hub. However, we do not hold the details of the level of funding they have made as a private company.</p> <p>I hope that this information is helpful. However, if you are not satisfied with the way we have handled your information request, you may complain or appeal our decision, which will be investigated through an Internal Review. If you are not content with the outcome of the Internal Review, you have the right to refer your complaint directly to the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) for a decision (contact details are available at: www.ico.org.uk). Please note that the ICO will usually expect you to have first exhausted our own complaints procedure before raising your concerns with them.</p>
