



Subject: Commons Registration Llanfairfechan
Request response
<p>Thank you for your request for information which we have handled under Freedom of Information legislation.</p> <p>You asked for a map submitted by the Crown Estate Commissioners to support an application to register common land in Llanfairfechan upland area for purposes of the Commons Registration Act 1965.</p> <p>I have attached plans which I believe cover the area in which you are interested. If they do not, please let me know.</p> <p>The registration of Welsh common land under the Common Land Registration Act was based on the attached plans, which have origins in early 19<sup>th</sup> century surveys of manors. These surveys established the boundaries of the Crown's manorial interests and are held at The National Archives under a series of plans in the LRRO1 series. The survey boundaries were originally captured on a series of 19<sup>th</sup> century Welsh Record Atlas and these boundaries were transposed onto Ordnance Survey contemporary mapping in Welsh Record Atlases in the 1960's. We believe they were then used for the commons registration.</p> <p>Each Common Registration Unit has a local authority 'CL' number for identification, which is marked on the plans. Commons Registration was carried out based on the old Welsh county boundaries which existed at the time and the official Commons Registration maps and registers are now held by the current relevant Welsh authority. The register of each common land unit comprises a Lands section, a Rights section and an Ownership section, which notes The Crown Estate as the owner.</p> <p>I hope that this information is helpful, but please get in touch if you would like more information. If you are not satisfied with this response, you may complain or appeal our decision, which will be investigated through an Internal Review. If you are not content with the outcome of the Internal Review, you have the right to refer your complaint directly to the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) for a decision (contact details are available at: <a href="http://www.ico.org.uk">www.ico.org.uk</a>). Please note that the ICO will usually expect you to have first exhausted our own complaints procedure before raising your concerns with them.</p>






