<p>I am writing further to your email of 15 November 2019 in which you asked for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).</p> <p>Specifically, you wrote:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><i>* Please disclose the amount paid in compensation in the financial years 2016/17, 2017/18 and 2018/19 for personal injuries to Crown Estate employees;</i><i>* Please disclose how many individual claims this represented;</i><i>* Please provide a breakdown showing the nature of the claim and injury, how much compensation was paid in each case and the total known third party legal fees paid.</i> <p>I can confirm that we hold no information relevant to your request, as there were no such claims.</p> <p>I hope that this response is helpful. However, if you are not satisfied with the way we have handled your information request, you may appeal our decision which will then be investigated through an internal review.
